Weather Alert Policy

Bowman Academy **does not** follow the Hillsborough County Public School’s policy for closings due to inclement weather. If a severe storm is approaching, Bowman Academy will make the decision to remain open or closed by 6:00 pm, the night before. A message will be sent to your email address and there will also be a message on the school answering machine. Teachers and assistants will attempt to contact you at your home number if school is closed. However, it is your responsibility to know the status of your child’s school. Information will also be posted on Fox 13 News, WFLA-NBC News, and Bay News 9.

School Hours

Before-Care: Before-Care begins at 7:30. Students who arrive between 7:30 and 8:30 will be charged Before Care fees.

School-Day: It is very important that your child not miss any early activities, so please arrive on time. The school day begins at 8:45 for all students and ends at 11:45. After Care charges begin at 12:00 and are provided daily until 6:00 pm.

Arrival: Students should be dropped off in the Front Drive-through Door, except for the 2 year old students, who should be walked to the 2-year-old Side Door after 8:30. If you choose to walk into the building with your child, please enter and exit through the Side Main Office door. **Please never walk up to the Front Drive-through Door.** Walking to the Front Drive-through Door creates congestion and safety concerns. Thank you for your cooperation.

If you arrive after 8:45, you may not enter through the Front Drive-through Door entrance, because you will disrupt a class in session. Please enter through the Side Main Office Door.

Nap and Lunch: Children who stay for lunch only, must be picked up at 12:45. Children who have not been picked up by 1:00 will be escorted to the nap room. Students in the Extended Academic Day program may be picked up at 1:45 if not staying for After Care. Children staying for nap may be picked up after 2:00 pm. Please inform the staff in the morning if your child will be staying for lunch or nap beyond regular school hours.

Please tell your child what his or her plans are for the day. This will prevent any unpleasant surprises!

If your child will be staying for nap, please send in a small blanket and pillow for naptime. These items will remain at school and will be sent home on Friday to be washed. We have limited storage space for these items, so please do not send large pillows or multiple blankets.

Dismissal: All students staying just for the school day are dismissed at 11:45. 2-year-old students are dismissed from their classroom. All other students will be escorted to your car by the Front Drive-through Door. **In the interest of safety, please utilize the Drive-through. Place the colored pick up card with your child's name in a visible spot on your dashboard.** Experience tells us that Drop Off and Pick Up will be delayed the first few days, but it does get better. Please have patience with us and other parents. Thank you!! If you choose to walk into the building for your child, please enter and exit through the side Office door.

Late Charges: Since we do not provide After-Care after 6:00 pm, a charge of \$1 per minute will be added after 6:00 pm.
