Body Parts:

La cabeza is the head

Los hombros are the shoulders

Las rodillas are the knees

Los Pies are the feet

La Boca is the mouth

La nariz is the nose

Los ojos are the eyes

El pelo is the hair

Los codos are the elbows

El estomago is the stomach

La frente is the forehead

El cuello is the neck

Las manos are the hands

Las orejas are the ears

Los dedos are the fingers

La lengua is the tongue

Los dientes are the teeth
