Literacy

We are almost finished with the alphabet! The last letter we will learn is Jj. Once we are finished with the alphabet we will start learning word families. The sight words will be: *it, is, of, play & on*. I will be sending home sight word paper books as a reinforcer.

Literacy Centers

The children have been enjoying spending time working in various literacy centers. The activities at these centers give students a fun and engaging way to practice early literacy skills and encourage social interactions. We will continue working in these centers each week.

Writing

The children have been doing a great job forming the letters we have learned. We will continue to practice the proper letter formation each week. This month, we will start to write the lowercase letters we haven't covered yet. During Writers Workshop, we will use a variety of stories, and the children will practice labeling their work. We will focus on writing the sounds we hear at the beginning and end of our words.

Math

We will continue our number study. We will be learning the numbers 15, 16, 17, & 18 and revisit the concepts of counting, graphing, patterning, and ordinal numbers. We will also start learning to combine and separate sets.

Science

In science we have been learning about the four seasons. We will now start to learn the characteristics of the day and night sky and how one changes into the other, as well as the objects in the sky - the sun and moon.
