Metropolitan Ministries

Personal Items

As the weather begins to change and the temperature drops, students may need light jackets to keep warm while out on the playground. Please be sure to write your child's name in their

jacket so we are able to easily identify who it belongs to.

Building Language Skills

Now that your child is well into the school year, you may begin to see a lot of growth with their speech/language skills. You may foster this growth by playing simple games, talking with your child while in the car, and by reading and discussing favorite books. There are so many fun fall holiday books and activities that can get your child excited and talking! Below are a few ideas to help you get started:

- * Show your child you are interested in what he/she has to say by repeating and expanding

on their comments. For example, if your child says, "pretty pumpkin," you can respond by saying, "Yes, that is a pretty orange pumpkin." You may say, "Look how bumpy the skin looks - let's touch it."

- * Use your child's trick or treat bag to collect items around the house. Ask them to locate items by category like toys with wheels or things people eat. When they put an item in the bag, talk about how it is used or what it looks and tastes like.

- * Ask your child to answer questions that require a choice. For example, you may say, "Do you want to read the silly pumpkin book or the scarecrow book?" Ask for their choice!
