## Literacy

What a wonderful year we have had! Students have worked so hard mastering the letters and sounds and we are now working on blending sounds together to read simple CVC words! Continued practice on sight words will help reading fluency over time so keep practicing! The May sight words are: SAID, LOOK, ME, HE, and SHE.

Your Child may have shared with you that we have been checking in on the animals at the San Diego Zoo each day during snack time. They have REALLY enjoyed seeing the live feeds and it's been a great opportunity to extend our learning. It has sparked a lot of unplanned conversation and we are going to spend some time diving into researching more about the animals we see each day.
