Literacy

What a wonderful year we have had! Our students have worked so hard mastering the letters and sounds of the alphabet. Last month, we worked on SH, TH, and CH digraphs. For the remainder of the year, we will work on short vowel word families. These mostly consist of CVC (consonant – vowel – consonant) words. During our word family studies, we will work on rhyming words as well. Please continue to practice ALL sight words at home! The May sight words are SAID, LOOK, ME, HE, and SHE.

Math

During the month of May, we will work on measuring with non-standard units of measure. We will use everyday objects, such as paper clips, pennies, cubes, and crayons, to measure the length of various objects. We will also introduce simple addition and subtraction sentences. We will focus on putting two groups of objects together and taking objects away. These concepts will use lots of hands-on practice in our pre-k 4 class! This month will also be a review of all learned concepts throughout the year, such as shapes, number writing, patterns, sorting, and using ten-frames.

Science

We have been learning all about the 4 seasons. During our study, we will discuss the changes that take place, such as weather, trees, animals, and the activities people do during each season. The kiddos will paint seasonal trees and create works of art related to our ever changing world. We will also plant flowers in our school garden and witness caterpillars grow and change into beautiful butterflies!
